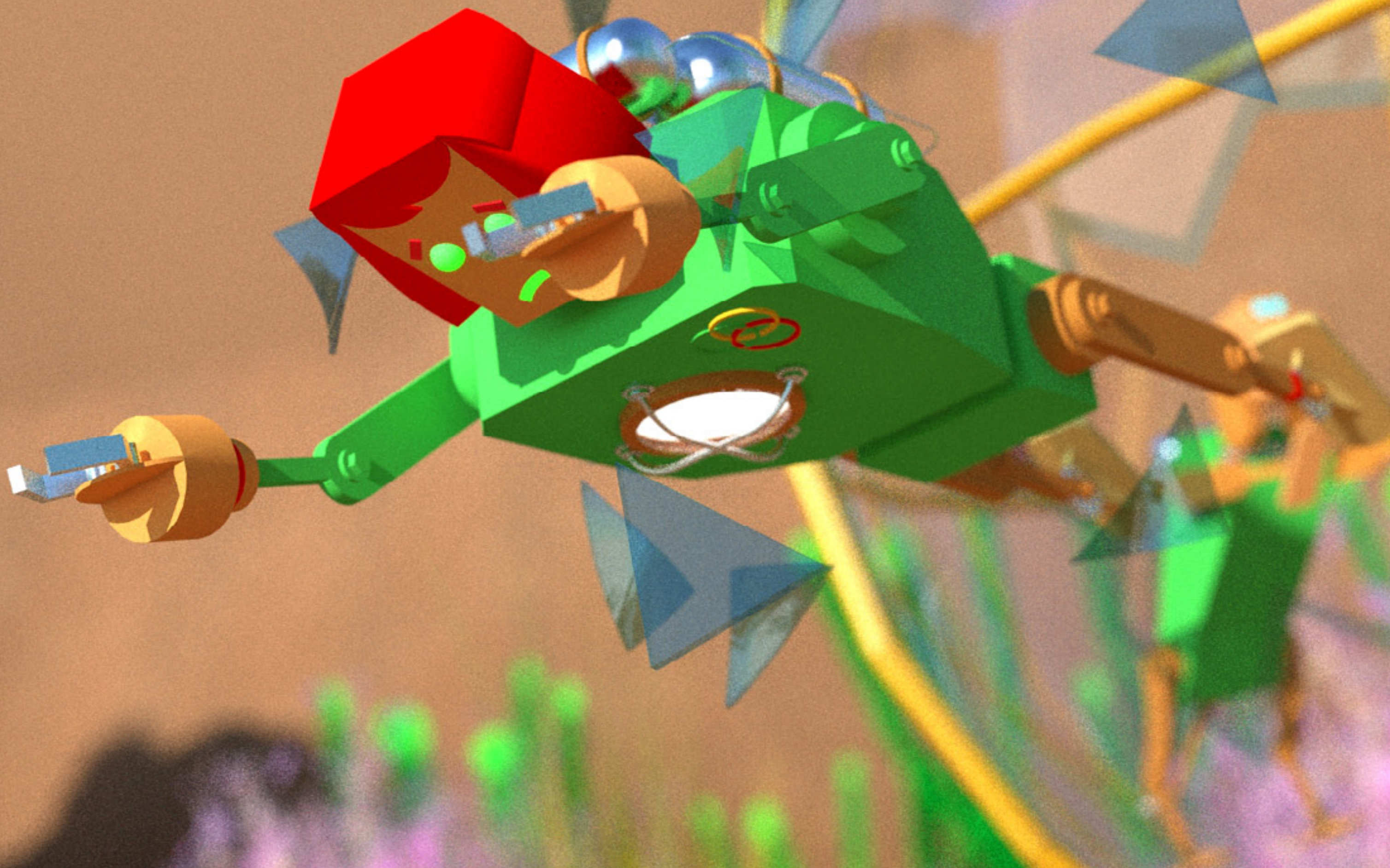
We have to get out.

One, two, three, throw me!

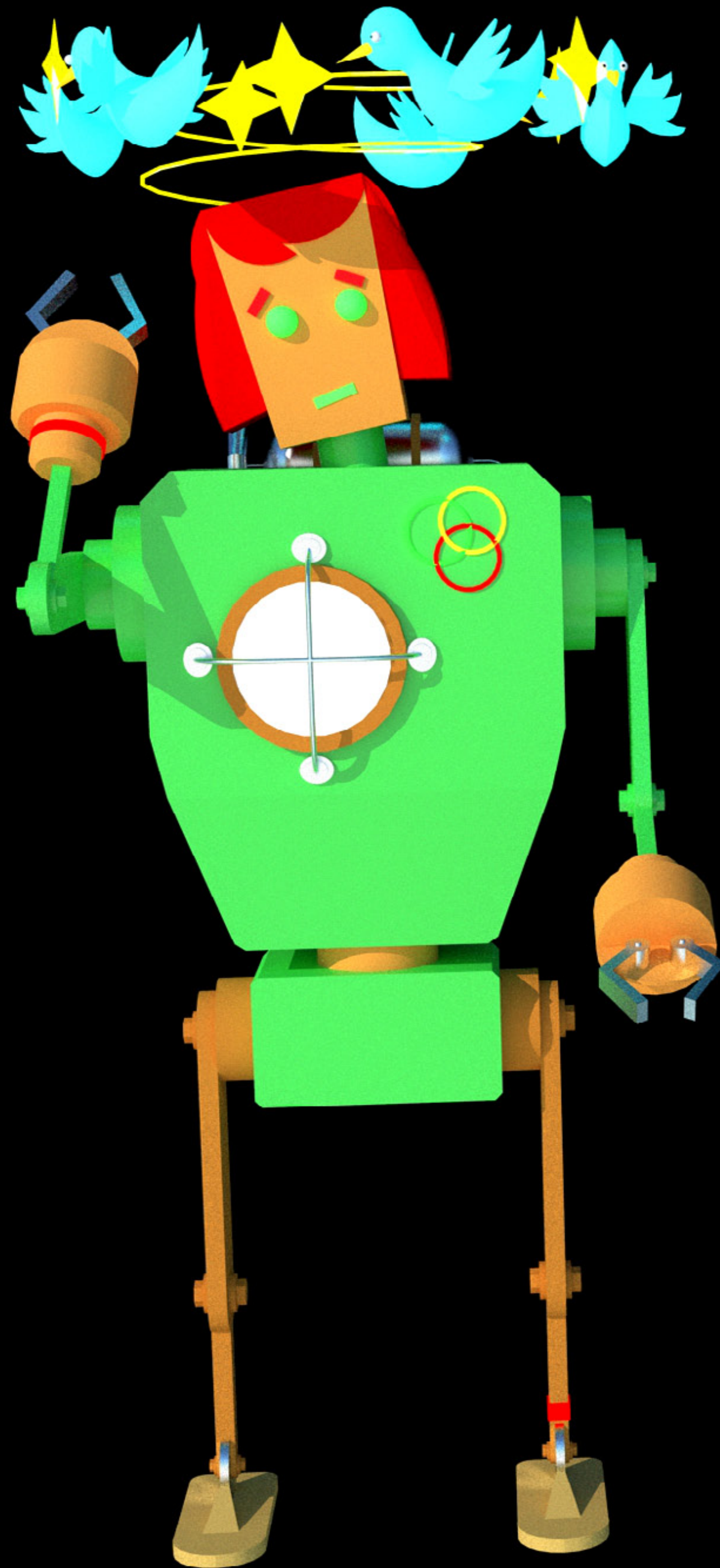

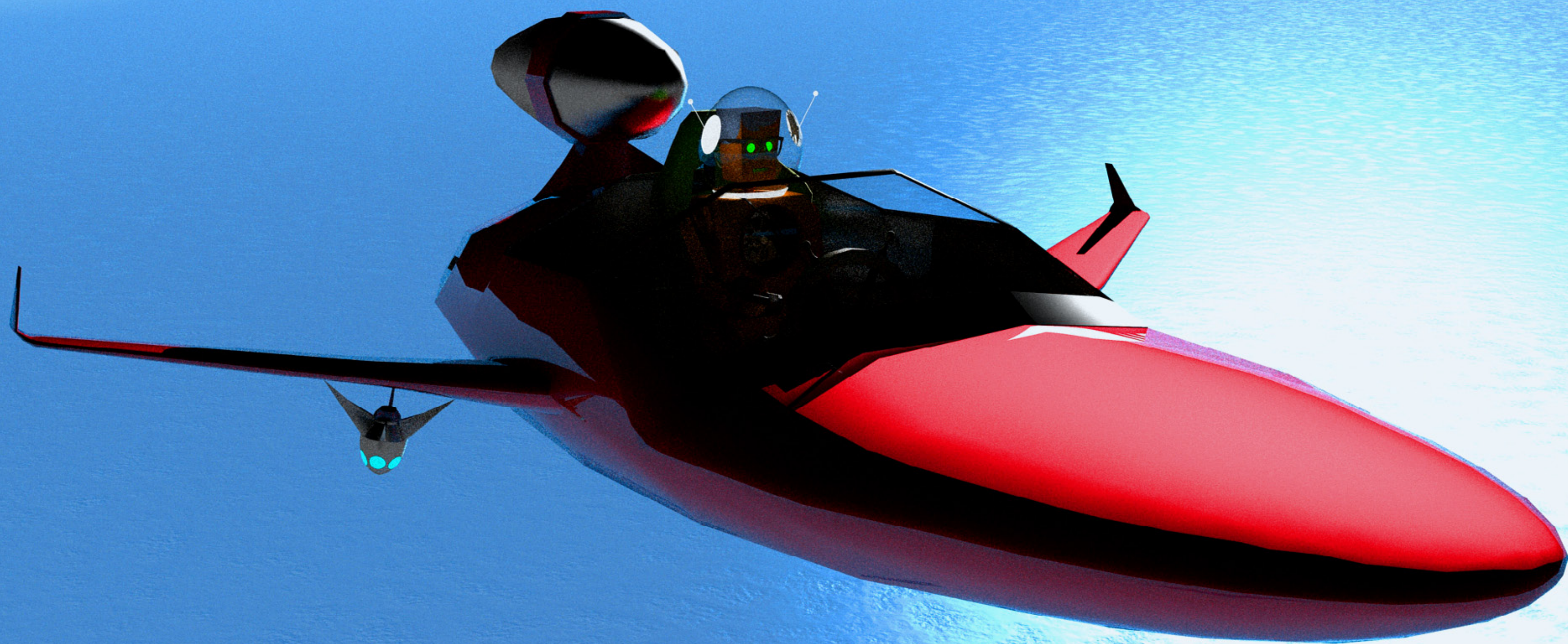
The Arkitekt is leaving!

Do me a favour.



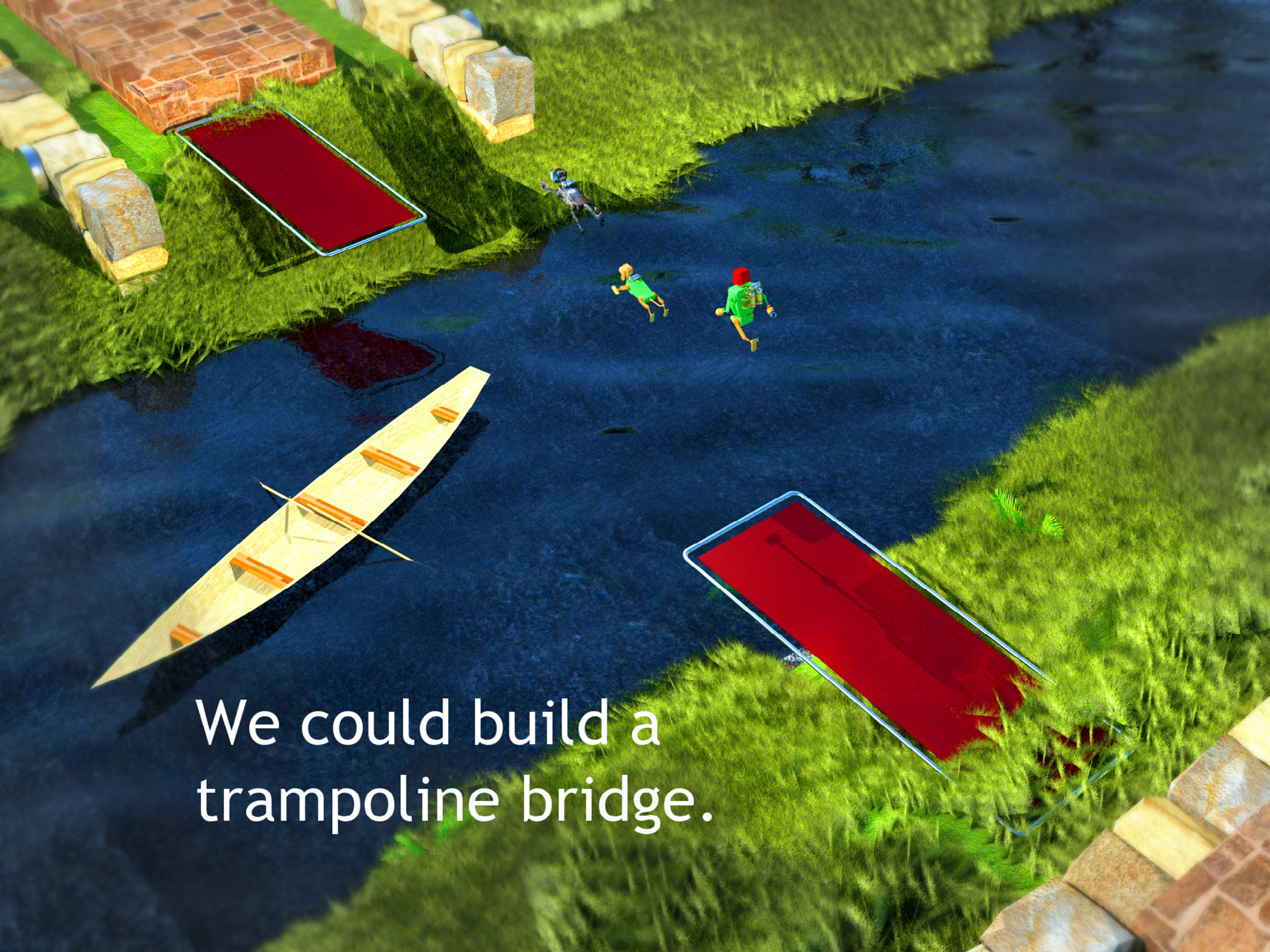
Do me a favour, replace the

boat has past.

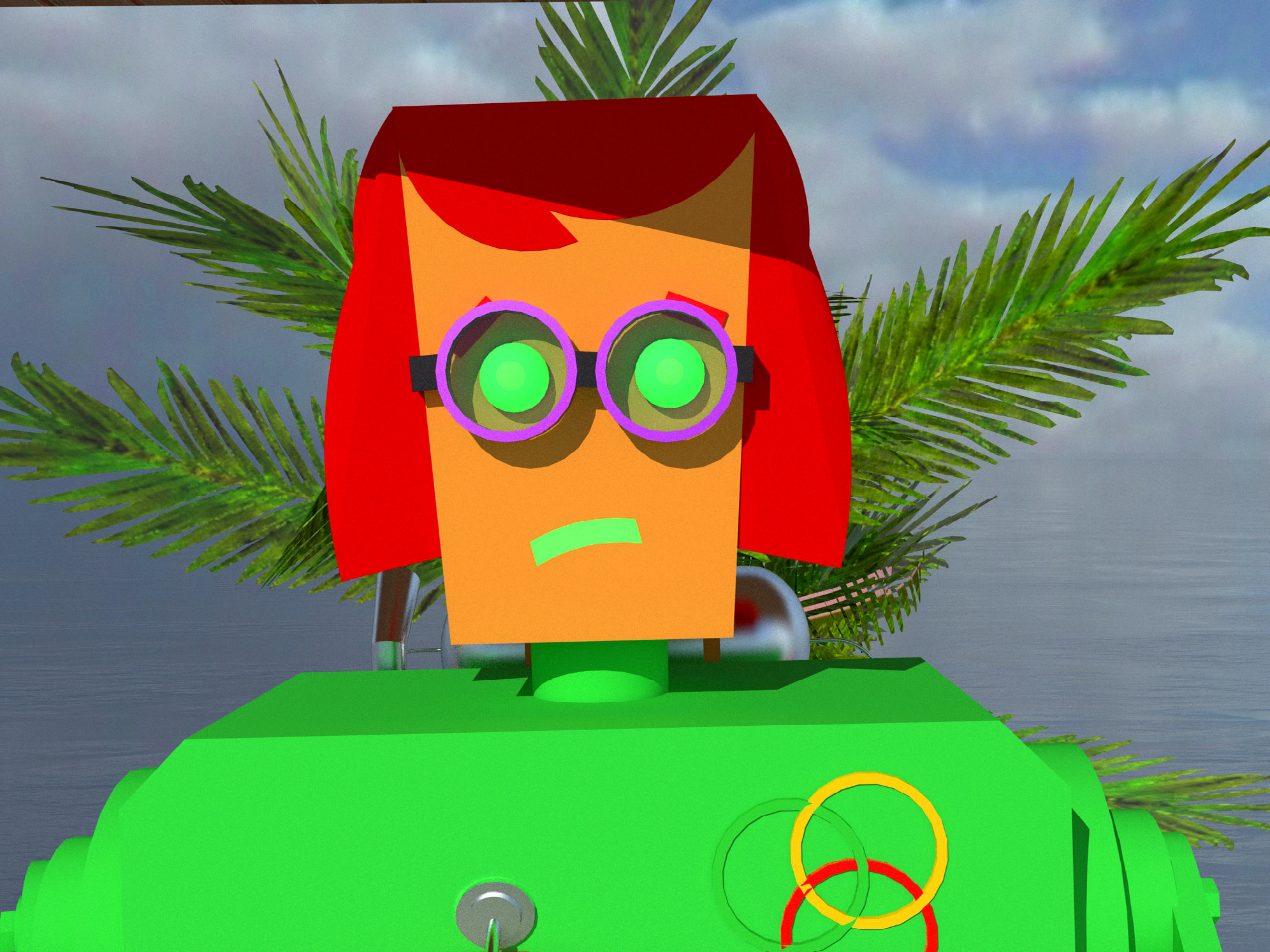

to help us get home!

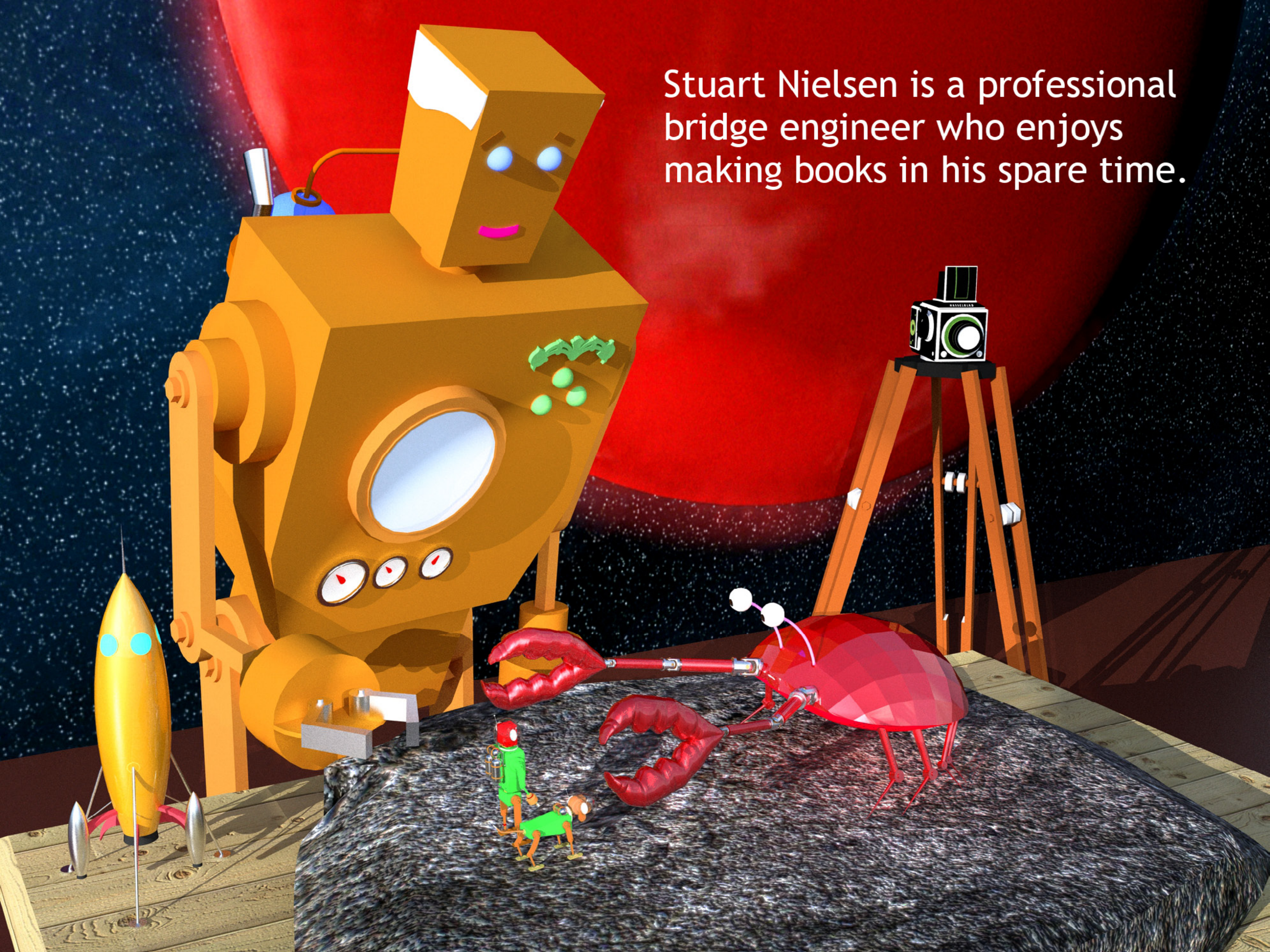
